

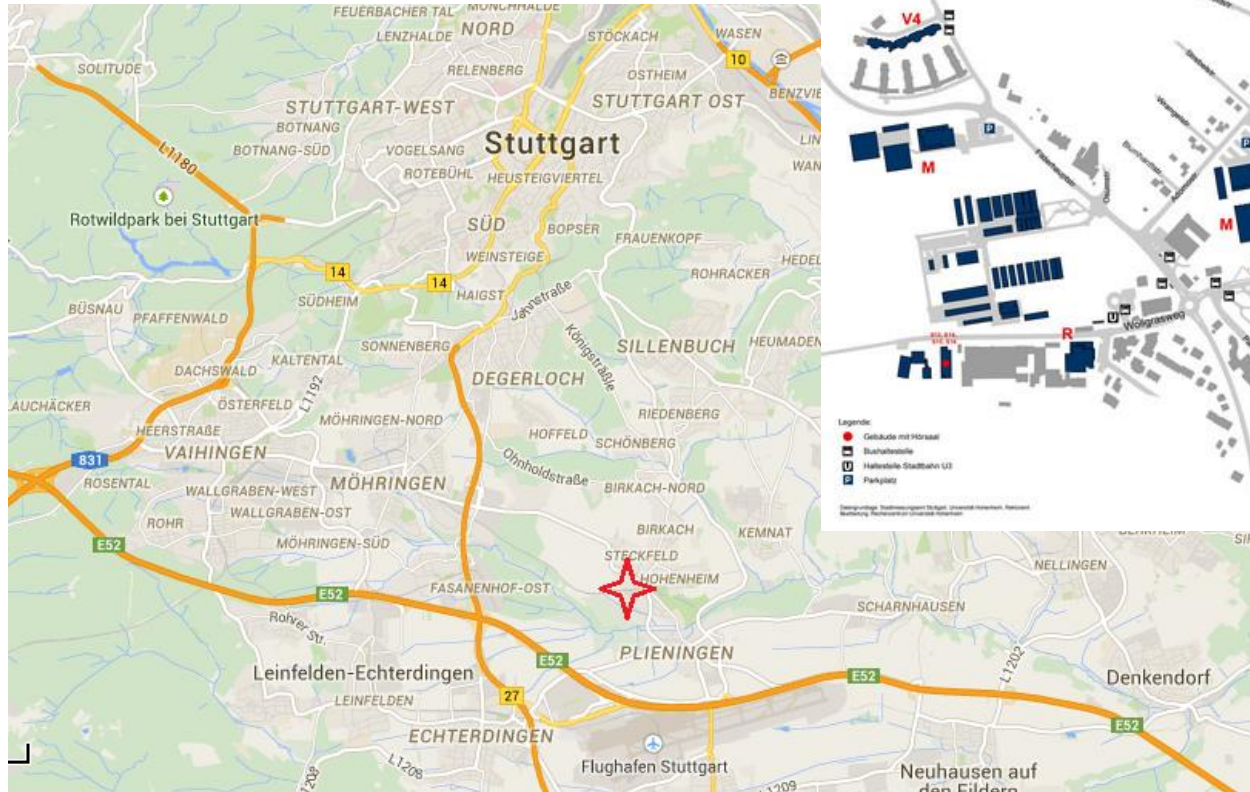

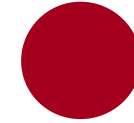

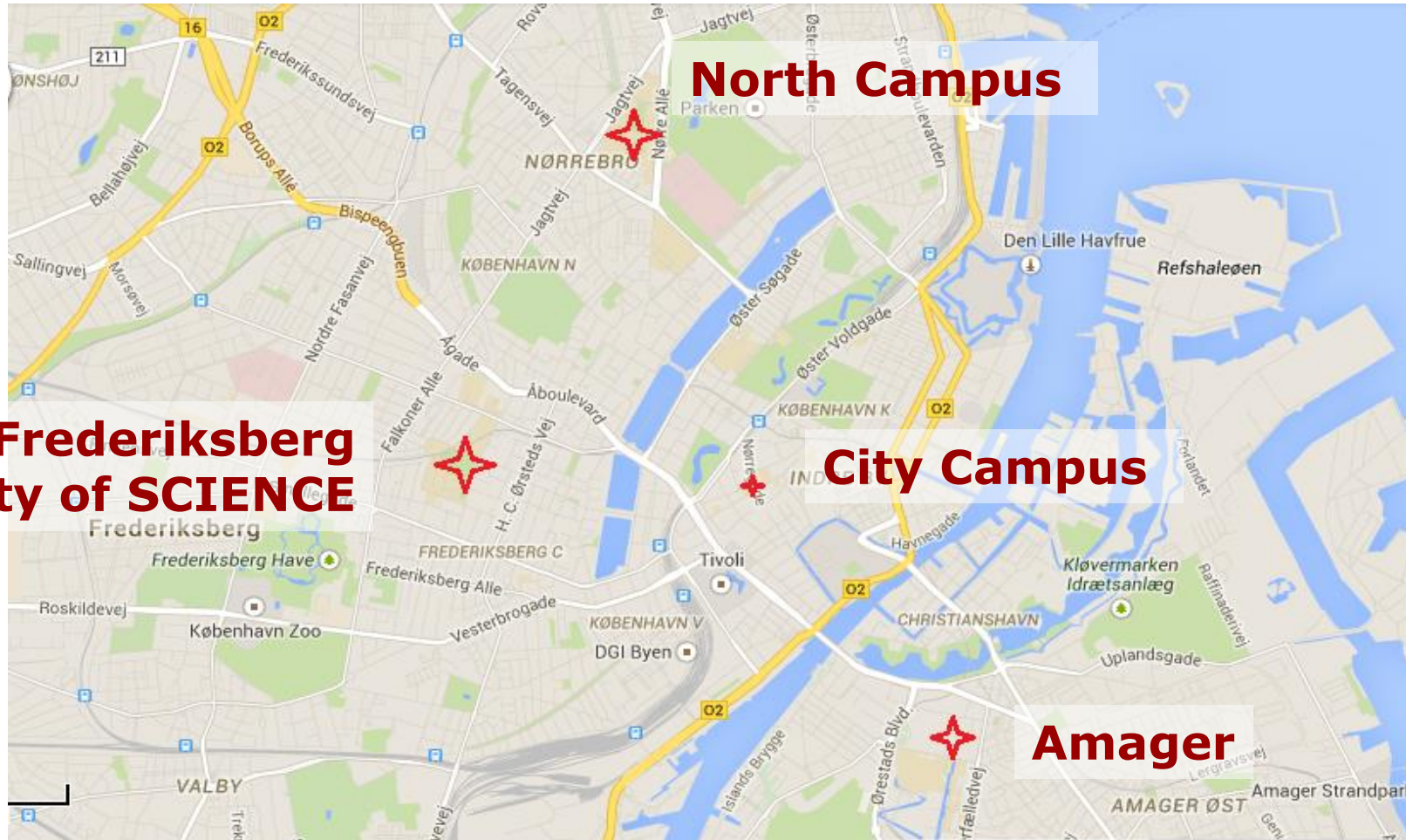

Canteen	2 canteens at Frederiksberg campus but quite small	one big canteen – one meal costs less than 3€
Language course	quite fun but not necessary – can use ECTS points	German courses offered at language center
Printing	500 b/w prints for free at faculty of SCIENCE	have to pay for each print, student ID card
ECTS	Each course: 7,5 ECTS	each course: 6 ECTS (at faculty of food science)
Beginning of lectures	around 1 <sup>st</sup> of September	12.10.2015
Money	more expensive than Austria – especially alcohol	about the same – food a bit cheaper
Teaching	a lot (!) of group work	quite demanding, maybe even in German
Party	friday bar	TMS – every thursday
